SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN

ACHIEVEMENT

1 YEAR GOAL:

- Increase 2017 ELA MPI from 422.9 to 426 in 2018.
- Increase 2017 Math MPI from 424.7 to 428 in 2018.
- Increase 2017 SSG MPI in ELA from 373.6 to 379 in 2018.

QFIC + 1

- Increase % of walkthroughs containing QFIC objective plus 1 by 2% from 43% to 45% or more by May of 2017-18.

Reading Cohort

- Increase reading cohort performance at or above grade level by 5% (grade 4 from 66% to 71% or higher and grade 5 from 62.7% to 67.7% or higher) as measured by GATES.
- The percent of students reading on or above grade level in each grade will increase by 5% from May 2017 to May 2018 as measured by Assessment Wall data.

Balanced Literacy

- By the end of the 2017-18 school year, implementation of small group literacy instruction with fidelity will increase from 78% to 85% based on scheduled literacy team walkthroughs.
- By the end of the 2017-18 school year, independent reading and writing will increase from 84% to 90% during Balanced Literacy block based on scheduled literacy team walkthroughs.

ATTENDANCE

1 YEAR GOAL:

- By the end of the 2017-2018 school year, Becky-David will increase the 90/90 attendance rate from 95.6% to 96%.
 - For the 2017-18 school year, Becky-David's daily attendance rate will increase from 96.2% to 96.5% or higher.
 - For the 2017-18 school year, Becky-David's percent of students missing 10+ days will decrease from 17% to 15% or less.
 - For the 2017-18 school year, Becky-David's number of students missing more than 18 days will decrease from 12 to 10 or less students.

BEHAVIOR

1 YEAR GOAL:

- By the end of the 2017-18 school year, Becky-David will decrease the number of incidents of OSS from 17 in 2016-17 to 15 or fewer in 2017-18.
- By the end of the 2017-18 school year, Becky-David will decrease the number of incidents of ISS from 16 in 2016-17 to 14 or fewer in 2017-18.
 - Becky-David will decrease the number of office referrals by 7% from 162 in 2016-17 to 150 or fewer in 2017-18.
 - Decrease the number of incidents of physical aggression by 10%

CLIMATE

- Surveys will continue to meet or exceed District climate performance expectations during the 2017-18 school year.
